## AMENDED CLASS CERTIFICATION ORDER

- 1. The Court orders this case be certified as a class action under Mo. R Civil P. 52.08.
- 2. The Court hereby defines the Class as follows:

All Persons Employed In Positions As Corrections Officer I Or Corrections Officer II By The Department Of Corrections Of The State Of Missouri At Any Time From August 14, 2007 To The Present Date for Claims Relating to Unpaid Straight-Time Compensation and From August 14, 2010 To The Present Date for Unpaid Overtime Compensation.

- The Court hereby appoints Thomas Hootselle, Daniel Dicus, Powell Meister & Beverly
   Ann Stevenson as Class Plaintiffs and Class Representatives.
- 4. The Court hereby appoints Gary Burger and the law firm of Cantor & Burger as Class Counsel for the Class.
- 5. The Court hereby orders Class Notice be sent by mail by counsel for Plaintiffs. The Court

hereby approves the class notice attached as Exhibit 1 to Plaintiffs' Motion for Amended Class Certification Order and to Approve Class Notice.

- 6. The Court hereby orders Defendants to provide a list of names, addresses, phone numbers, and email addresses of Class members, in a useable data format, for purposes of providing class notice within five days of the entry of this Order.
- 7. The Court orders Class Counsel to maintain a page on its website containing pertinent information regarding this class action for class members.
- 8. The Court orders that the Class shall have 90 days from the date class notice is mailed to opt out of this class action. The Court orders Class Counsel to report to Defendants within 10 days after the 90 day opt out time peiord of any individuals opting out of the Class.
