**SKILLED ANTITRUST AND LEGISLATIVE ATTORNEY AMANDA LEWIS
JOINS “UNIQUE” CUNEO GILBERT & LADUCA**

Washington, DC, September 7 – [Amanda G. Lewis](#) has joined Cuneo Gilbert & LaDuca, LLP (CGL), a Washington, DC based law firm, as an attorney focusing on antitrust matters and government relations. Previously, since 2012, she was an attorney with the Federal Trade Commission’s Bureau of Competition. There, she served for more than two and-a-half years as Counsel-Detailee to the House Judiciary Subcommittee on Antitrust, Commercial and Administrative Law.

Noting that CGL founder [Jonathan W. Cuneo](#) was also an FTC attorney, a former counsel to the House Antitrust Subcommittee and someone who helped start the Committee to Support Antitrust Laws (COSAL), Ms. Lewis said CGL is unique among law firms. CGL chairman, [Charles J. LaDuca](#), is a leading litigator of class action lawsuits on behalf of consumers harmed by dangerous products and homeowners by defective building materials, she added.

“Amanda Lewis is a talented, skillful antitrust and legislative attorney who brings greater depth to our growing practice in these areas,” explained Charles J. LaDuca, CGL’s chairman. “She is a great addition to our firm.”

While on detail to the House Judiciary Subcommittee, Ms. Lewis led the portion of the Subcommittee’s Digital Markets Investigation related to Amazon, was a co-author of the 450-page Majority Staff Report and Recommendations, and helped draft bipartisan legislation currently moving in Congress to rein in Big Tech. She also oversaw several Subcommittee hearings on competition in healthcare and a successful bi-partisan markup of four healthcare industry antitrust bills unanimously reported out of the full Committee. In this role, Ms. Lewis also oversaw the enactment of the 2019 CREATES Act to stop anticompetitive pharmaceutical market practices, and the 2021 Competitive Health Insurance Reform Act to improve transparency and competition in the health insurance marketplace.

As an attorney for the FTC's Mergers IV Division, Ms. Lewis worked on the Staples/Office Depot and Sysco/US Foods litigation teams, among other high-profile merger investigations and cases.
